Resurrection Joy in a Fearful World

He is risen, He is risen indeed. Alleluia. Easter is upon us, and the Lent season behind us. What a beautiful season here at Our Savior's as each Wednesday evening we gathered to fellowship while eating; to sing Holden Evening Prayer; to hear God's word, reflect and pray together. We were well prepared for celebrating the first Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday; to reflect quietly on Jesus crucifixion at the Good Friday services; and to celebrate Jesus' resurrection on Easter morning.

Bishop Dr, Munib Younan, President of the Lutheran World Federation preached "Resurrection Joy in a Fearful World" in his Easter message reminding us that "They could crucify Jesus, but they could not bury Jesus. They **could not bury God's love for the world.**" (lutheranworld.org).

Today's world may cause us to wonder if God's love has been buried in our world. The Easter promise refutes those thoughts yet we can have our doubts. And when we doubt, we have a choice in how we respond: harden our souls into cynicism OR to face it with mercy and grace.

Anne Lamott says that we are often tempted to allow anger and anxiety to take over our lives, and drive our actions because " Our self-centered fears whisper at us all day: our fear of exposure, of death, and that we will lose those we love most, that we will lose whatever advantage we hold, whatever meager gains we've made. " However, as God's children, we also have a great capacity for mercy and forgiveness.

Lamott continues "Mercy is radical kindness. Mercy means offering or being offered aid in desperate straits. Mercy is not deserved. It involves absolving the unabsolvable, forgiving the unforgivable. Mercy brings us to the miracle of apology, given and accepted, to unashamed humility when we have erred or forgotten."

Jesus was killed by fickle cynics who feared he would take away their power. Their souls were hardened. Jesus calls us to live out the Easter promise of hope in our actions of mercy, forgiveness and kindness with the goal of creating the compassion and peace he promised to leave with us.

Easter is the time for us to be active in our faith and spread Christ's joy and hope to those in need. May you trust Gods Easter promises, bring resurrection joy into our fearful world with kindness and mercy!

Council Update

Your church council met on April 6 and the following was discussed:

- Pastor Deb, Pastor Dave and Sheri Dittrich-Reinhart shared some ideas and information they received at the equipping congregation workshop in February.
- Pastor Deb and Marilyn Sharpe, and expert in the area of children, youth and family ministry will be meeting with parent focus groups to hear feedback and ideas about our ministry to children, youth and families at Our Savior's.
- The Council reviewed a letter from Becky Eikanger indicating she will be stepping back to a volunteer role as of June 18, 2017. The council accepted her resignation and will thank her in worship on June 18. A letter will be sent to the congregation after Easter.
- Our Savior's Will be sending our yearly donation to continue supporting Green Lake Bible Camp.
- Building & Grounds is continuing plans on updates to our sound system thanks to generous gifts from anonymous donors. The project is currently out for bids.
- Our Savior's received a thank you note from the Southwestern Minnesota Synod for our mission support this year.
- Basket auction, rent-a-kid service projects and "Adventures in Wilderness" dinner are underway in April to raise money for this Summer's Boundary Waters trip.

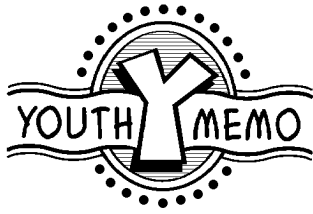
